

Government Reporting on Gender and Race/Ethnicity
(REQUIRED FORM, RETURN TO CENTRAL CASTING)

Central Casting is subject to government recordkeeping and reporting requirements, so it invites you to voluntarily self-identify your gender and race/ethnicity. Refusing to do so will not result in adverse treatment, and casting directors and other Central Casting personnel will not have access to this information for casting purposes. Your responses will be kept confidential and used only as permitted by applicable laws and regulations, including anonymized data reporting to the government for civil rights enforcement. The data reported will not identify you by name. The questions below follow the format required by the government.

Note: If you decline to self-identify your gender or race/ethnicity, the government requires Central Casting to make a best guess or determination by visual survey and/or other available information.

What is your gender? (SELECT ONLY ONE GENDER CHOICE BELOW)

What is your race/ethnicity? (SELECT ONLY ONE RACE / ETHNICITY CHOICE BELOW)

- ☐ **Hispanic or Latino** – Individuals of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Salvadoran, Cuban, Dominican, Guatemalan, and other Central or South American or Spanish culture or origin.
- ☐ **White (But Not Hispanic or Latino)** – Individuals with origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, including, for example, English, German, Irish, Italian, Polish, and Scottish.
- ☐ **Black or African American (But Not Hispanic or Latino)** – Individuals with origins in any of the Black racial groups of Africa, including, for example, African American, Jamaican, Haitian, Nigerian, Ethiopian, and Somali.
- ☐ **Middle Eastern or North African (But Not Hispanic or Latino)** – Individuals with origins in any of the original peoples of the Middle East or North Africa, including, for example, Lebanese, Iranian, Egyptian, Syrian, Iraqi, and Israeli.
- ☐ **Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander (But Not Hispanic or Latino)** – Individuals with origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands, including, for example, Native Hawaiian, Samoan, Chamorro, Tongan, Fijian, and Marshallese.
- ☐ **Asian (But Not Hispanic or Latino)** – Individuals with origins in any of the original peoples of Central or East Asia, Southeast Asia, or South Asia, including, for example, Chinese, Asian Indian, Filipino, Vietnamese, Korean, and Japanese.
- ☐ **American Indian or Alaska Native (But Not Hispanic or Latino)** – Individuals with origins in any of the original peoples of North, Central, and South America, including, for example, Navajo Nation, Blackfeet Tribe of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation of Montana, Native Village of Barrow Inupiat Traditional Government, Nome Eskimo Community, Aztec, and Maya.
- ☐ **Two or More Races (But Not Hispanic or Latino)** – A person who primarily identifies with two or more of the above race/ethnicity categories.
