

# Signing in to SmartAccounting using Citrix Cloud

As part of Entertainment Partners' ongoing commitment to develop global, client-first solutions, SmartAccounting will transition to Citrix Cloud on Sept 6, 2025. This user guide will walk you through how to log in to your show using Citrix Cloud.

- Go to <https://sa.ep.com> or follow the links provided in the email if you received an Action Required email from EP at [products.no\\_reply@ep.com](mailto:products.no_reply@ep.com).

**Note:** You will no longer need to use <https://connect.ep.com/>, <https://connect-eu.ep.com/> or <https://connect-au.ep.com/> depending on your territory. If you access one of those URLs, it will automatically redirect you to our Citrix Cloud page: <https://sa.ep.com>.

- Step 1** The first time you access the Citrix Cloud page, you will be greeted with a Citrix Workspace screen asking you to detect your workspace version. **Click** on “Detect Workspace version.” This will detect if Citrix Workspace is already installed on your computer.

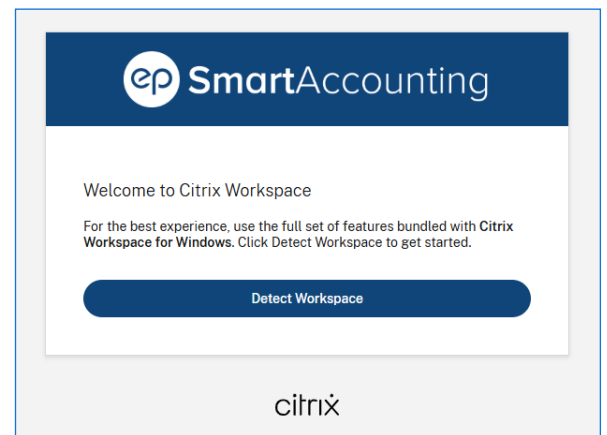

- Step 2** If you don't have Citrix Workspace installed on your computer or if the dialog box does not appear on the “Detect Workspace version” screen, **click** on the “I agree with the Citrix License agreement” checkbox and **select** the download button.

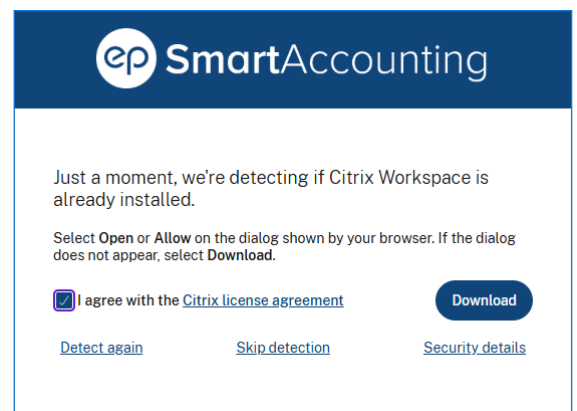

- Step 3** This will download the latest Citrix Workspace to your computer. Once the download is completed, go to your browser's downloads folder, open, and install the Citrix Workspace application on your computer.

**Note:** You will need to have admin-level access to your computer to successfully install Citrix Workspace.

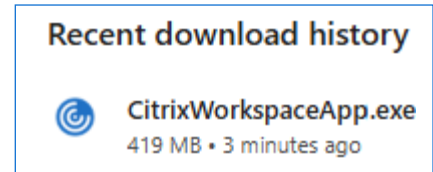

- Step 4** Once Citrix Workspace is installed, close and re-open your web browser and go to <https://sa.ep.com>. This will now detect your installed Citrix Workspace version.

- Step 5** If you already have a Citrix Workspace version installed on your computer, you will see a dialog screen asking to open the Citrix Receiver Launcher. **Click** on the box that says, “Always allow sa.ep.com to open links of this type in the associated app” and then **click** on the “Open Citrix Receiver Launcher” button.

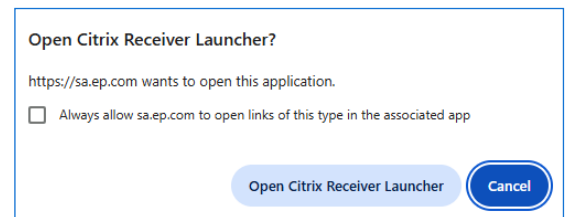




- Step 8** On the MFA prompt screen, enter the MFA passcode generated by the same authentication method you use for your other EP products.

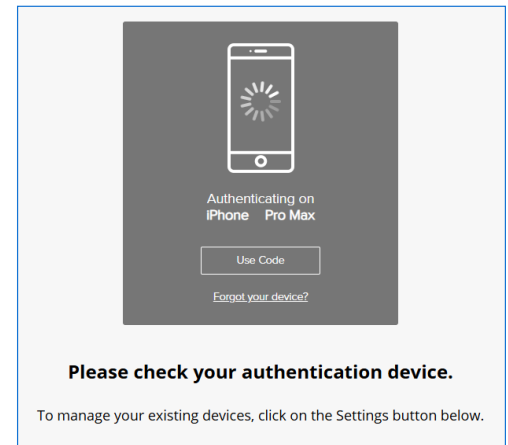

- Step 9** You will then be presented with a list of your available SmartAccounting shows.

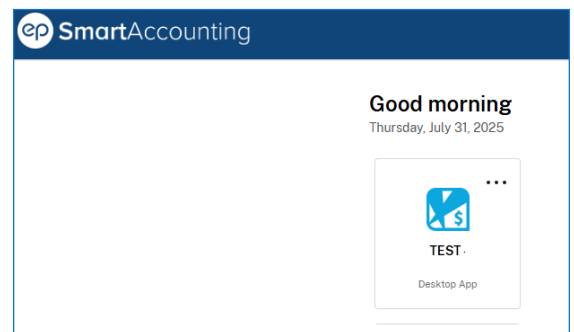

- Step 10** **Double click** on the show icon you would like to access; this will launch your SmartAccounting show.

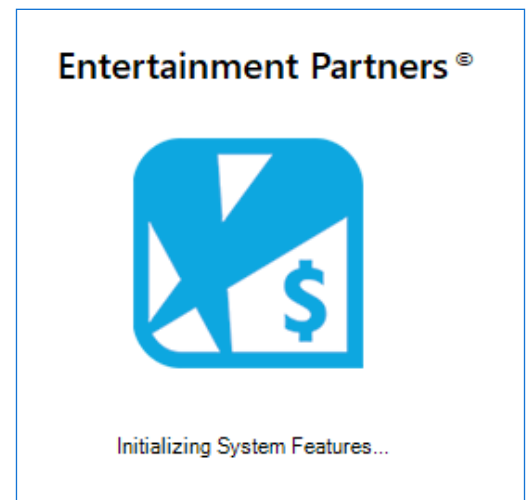

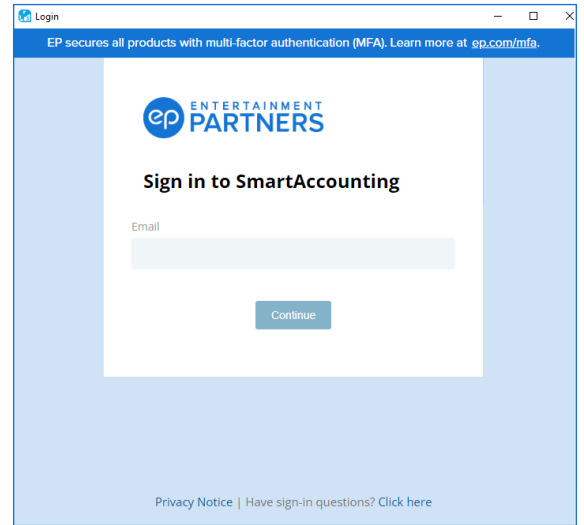

- Step 12** Enter your password, and then **click** on “Sign in.”

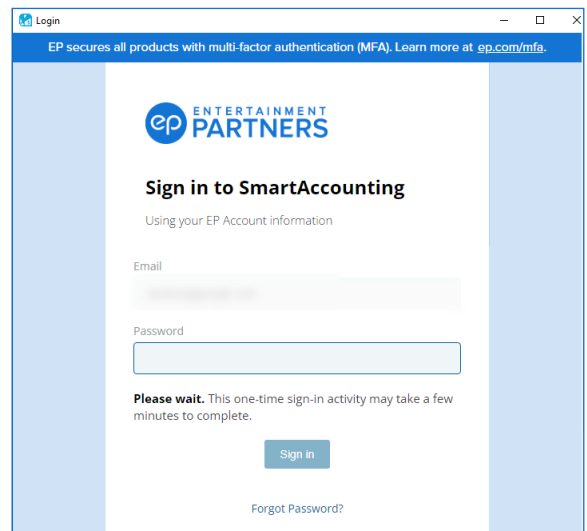

You will then be greeted with the SmartAccounting Welcome page.

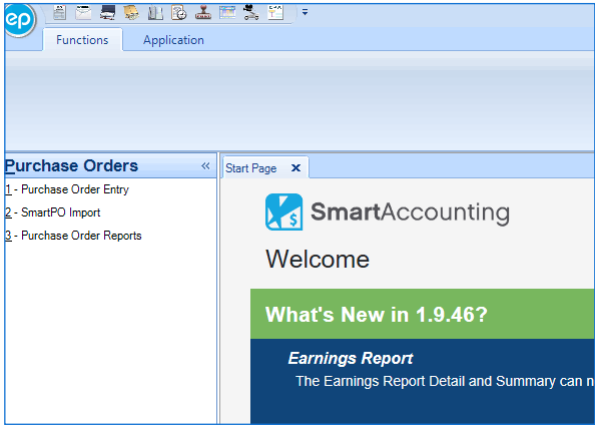
