Movie Magic Budgeting on macOS Ventura

1. When is macOS Ventura available to the general public?

According to [Apple's website](#), the general release to all users is expected to be Monday, October 24, 2022.

2. Does the New Movie Magic Budgeting work with macOS Ventura?

Yes, the New Movie Magic Budgeting (MMB10) is fully compatible with macOS Ventura.

3. How do I know what version of Movie Magic Budgeting I have?

The version number of the application is located under the Apple icon in the top menu in the About MMB screen.

To access the About screen on macOS:

- i. Open Movie Magic Budgeting.
- ii. Click on the Apple icon from the top menu and select About Movie Magic Budgeting.

The version number is listed at the top of the About screen.

4. Do older versions of Movie Magic Budgeting work with macOS Ventura?

Movie Magic Budgeting (MMB7 or earlier) is not compatible with macOS Ventura. EP recommends users upgrade to the New Movie Magic Budgeting (MMB10) for compatibility with macOS Ventura.

5. What does “not compatible” mean?

EP has found that third party technology used in Movie Magic Budgeting (MMB7) does not operate on macOS Ventura.



6. Will Movie Magic Budgeting (MMB7) or earlier be verified to work on macOS Ventura?

EP cannot guarantee compatibility of macOS Ventura and encourages users to upgrade to the New Movie Magic Budgeting (MMB10). Users can purchase the New Movie Magic Budgeting (MMB10) [here](#) along with instructions for installation.
