MFA instructions for eShare

EShare is a link-based collaboration platform used by Entertainment Partners (EP) to transfer information to you and your organization. To access secure messages from eShare, you must create an EP Account and set up Multi-factor Authentication (MFA).

Your EP Account is the username (email) and password you will use to sign in to EP products and other integrated services. MFA then further enhances security and reduces the risk of unauthorized access by providing an extra layer of protection. Everyone requires unique credentials to access all EP products and other integrated services, like eShare. Sharing credentials is a security risk, and there are no supported options to bypass MFA.

Note: If you currently share credentials to access eShare, follow the steps below to create your own EP Account and set up MFA.

Step 1 Open your invitation email. Then, click View message.




Figure 1: Invitation email sample, View message

Step 2 You will be taken to your sign-in screen.
Enter the same email address you use to receive your eShare invitations. Click Continue.




Figure 2: EP Account sign-in screen

Accessing eShare: I Have an EP Account and MFA

Before your get started: If your eShare invitations go to a different email address than your EP Account address, you will need separate EP Accounts and MFA setups for each address. Or reach out to your usual EP point of contact to change where you receive your invitations.

Step 1 If you have an EP Account that you use to access your other EP products, enter your usual password. Then, click Sign in.




Figure 3: Password entry

Step 2 Enter your MFA passcode when prompted to complete your sign-in.

Before your get started: If your eShare invitations go to a different email address than your EP Account address, you will need separate EP Accounts and MFA setups for each address. Or reach out to your usual EP point of contact to change where you receive your invitations.

Step 1 Enter your usual EP Account password. Then, click Sign in.




Figure 4: Password entry screen

Step 2 The Welcome screen will be displayed. Click START to begin your MFA setup.




Figure 5: Welcome screen




Figure 6: Add a New Device screen

Step 1 Click Register now.




Figure 7: Password entry




Figure 8: Account Creation screen, Finish

Step 4 The Welcome screen will be displayed. Click START to begin your MFA setup.




Figure 9: Welcome screen
