



Supporting Artist Rates: Outside London

If you work as a supporting artist on a film or TV show outside London, you’ll likely be paid according to the [Pact/Equity Agreement](#). “Outside London” is anywhere outside a 40-mile radius of Charing Cross.

Different rates apply for day, night and shift work. You may also be entitled to supplementary fees and travel and meal allowances.

Rates

Types of pay	Rate
Basic daily rate (BDR)	£114.39
Holiday pay (added to BDR)	£13.81
Overtime (per 30 mins or part thereof)	£9.53
Costume fitting (up to four hours)	£57.20
Costume fitting holiday pay (up to four hours)	£6.14
Public holiday / night call enhancement	£57.20
Public holiday / night call overtime per 30 mins (or part thereof)	£14.30

Supplementary fees

You may be asked to perform specific activities or bring particular clothing, for which you’ll receive a supplementary fee.

Category	Activities	Fee
SP1	Creative contribution	£32.46
SP2	Firearms; swimming; driving; horse riding; dancing	£27.05
SP3	Clothing change (artist’s own); special clothing provision; haircut; wetting down; vehicle provision	£20.00

Travel allowances

The following allowances cover you getting to and from the shoot.

Travel details	Allowance
Travel between 0-3.99 miles of base/location	£4.00*
Travel between 4-10.99 miles of base/location	£11.00
Travel between 11-40 miles of base/location	£16.00
Travel exceeding a 40-mile radius of base/location	£20.00
Uplift payable on calls made before 6am (7am on Sundays or bank holidays)	£9.00**

*Negotiated but capped at the stated amount.
**This uplift doesn’t apply to travel between 0-3.99 miles of the base/location.

Meal allowances

If food isn’t provided by the production, you’ll receive the following allowances.

Meal	Allowance
Breakfast/lunch	£5.00
Dinner	£10.00

Meal penalties

One or more of the following meal penalties might also apply.

Type of penalty	Day shoot	Night shoot
Broken lunch (paid if your first meal break isn’t given until five-and-a-half to six hours after your call time)	£8.94	£13.37
Broken lunch (paid if your first meal break isn’t given within six hours of your call time)	£17.88	£26.74
Second broken meal (paid if your second meal break isn’t given until five-and-a-half to six hours after your first meal break (note: your second meal break must never be more than 12 hours after your call time))	£8.94	£13.37
Second broken meal (paid if your second meal break isn’t given within six hours of your call time (note: your second meal break must never be more than 12 hours after your call time))	£17.88	£26.74
